RESOLUTION NO. 2017-020

RESOLUTION ADOPTING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2017-171 - AN ORDINANCE DECLARING EVERY 15TH AND 16TH DAY OF MARCH AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER AS THE YLANG-YLANG FESTIVAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANAO AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, in 1988, the Provincial Government of Tarlac headed by then Provincial Governor Mar Un Ocampo III conceived of a development thrust that would improve the economic status of the province. It was through the Rural Industrialization Can Happen (RICH) Program that a potential industrial crop was to be identified from each of the 17 municipalities of the province. An ocular inspection of Anao by the Technology and Livelihood Research Center (TLRC) experts observed that there were 72 flowering trees that abound in backyards around town, and this prompted the TLRC to recommend the development of the ylang-ylang essential oil extraction project for Anao as part of the RICH program. The potential as a dollar earner convinced the Municipal Government of Anao to venture into a large-scale propagation of ylang-ylang;

WHEREAS, the project started in 1989 under the administration of then Mayor Clemente T. Apuan who exerted all efforts to cause the planting of ylang-ylang trees. Over the years, Anao became a beneficiary of essential oil extractors to help in the essential oil extraction project which became Anao's One Town, One Project (OTOP) in 1995. In 1998, under the administration of former Mayor Rodolfo F. Guerrero, the ylang-ylang essential oil as product was formally launched at Mimosa Hotel in Pampanga, and from then the continues development of new products out of the ylang-ylang essential oil which was later introduced with the brand name AROMA ANAO and exhibited in Paris, France on April 12-14, 2005. In 2009, under the leadership of Mayor Edgardo S. Felipe, the brand name AROMA ANAO was registered at the Intellectual Property Office Philippines (IPOPhil) wherein the project was requested for assistance by the said agency and luckily was chosen as beneficiary of a grant/assistance from the Korean Intellectual Property Office (KIPO), Korean Invention Promotion Association (KIPA). The essential oil extractor through the Department of Science and Technology III (DOST-3) grant and aid was also converted into a boiler system, thus, a more controlled heat and better quality of oil which is already close to the global market's standard;

WHEREAS, inspired by the success of the first Ylang-Ylang Festival held on May 30, 1996, the following year and every year thereafter, it already coincides with the founding anniversary of the establishment of Anao into a town;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anao is known for its Ylang-Ylang Essential Oil Extraction Project;


WHEREAS, in gesture of thanksgiving and resolve, Anao's annual town fiesta shall henceforth be known as the Ylang-Ylang Festival and to be registered at the Intellectual Property Office- Philippines (IPOPhil);

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Anao in Session assembled hereby enacts:






MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2017-171

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan

SECTION 1. Title

The 15th and 16th day of March and every year thereafter is hereby set aside to hold an "Ylang-Ylang Festival" in the Municipality of Anao.

SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy

It shall be the declared policy of the Municipality to celebrate the Ylang-Ylang Festival for a bountiful harvest and to awaken the people's awareness and understanding of the Anaoenos' ylang-ylang industry.

SECTION 3. Source of Funds

The funds necessary for the conduct of said festival shall be appropriated in the Annual Budget.

SECTION 4. Effectivity

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.






