





RESOLUTION NO. 2016-105

RESOLUTION ENACTING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2016-168 – AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PICKING OF YLANG-YLANG FLOWERS AND FRUITS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF ANAO, TARLAC.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government recognizes the need to ensure the survival of these ylang-ylang trees to promote the essential oil extraction project which promises to be lucrative sources of income for the Municipality of Anao;

WHEREAS, it has been observed that there is no existing ordinance regulating the picking of ylang-ylang flowers and fruits;

WHEREAS, there is a need to enact an ordinance regulating the picking of ylang-ylang flowers and fruits within the jurisdiction of Anao, Tarlac;

WHEREAS, the success of the Municipality's major livelihood program rests on the cooperation of all the constituents of the Municipality in the propagation and culture of ylang-ylang trees;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Coun. Johanna Donata A. Caymo and seconded by the Body.

RESOLVED that this Body hereby enacts:

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2016-168

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PICKING OF YLANG-YLANG FLOWERS AND FRUITS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF ANAO, TARLAC.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF ANAO, THAT:

Section 1. TITLE

The Ordinance shall be known as Regulating the Picking of Ylang-Ylang Flowers and Fruits within the Jurisdiction of the Municipality of Anao.

Section 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS

For purposes of this Ordinance, the terms hereunder cited shall be defined as follows:


- a. Authorized Pickers – are authorized and well trained Anaoños who will pick or harvest ylang-ylang flowers or fruits;
- b. Ylang-Ylang Flowers – are flowers of ylang-ylang trees for extraction;
- c. Ylang-Ylang fruits – are fruits of ylang-ylang trees which are ripened and are ready for harvest;
- d. Regulating – means control or guidelines on the picking of ylang-ylang flowers and fruits;





1. A group of pickers for every barangay preferably its residents shall have the primary authorization to pick flowers and fruits;
2. The group of Pickers shall be under the direct control of Supervisors of the livelihood and Tourism Officer;
3. The group of pickers shall undergo seminars and training regarding ylang-ylang projects as may deemed necessary;
4. Pickers must be legal age, ages 18 years old and above;
5. All authorized Pickers are oblige to Register at the LGU to be recognize as legitimate pickers;
6. Prior to the picking schedule, all Authorized Pickers are mandated to report to the Barangay Council concern for recognition.

Section 4. PENALTY PROVISION

A Picker who violates the provision of this Ordinance shall be as follows:

1 st offense	-	3 hours community service
2 nd offense	-	8 hours community service
3 rd offense	-	2 days community service

Section 5. COMPROMISE SETTLEMENT CLAUSE

The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an out-of-court or extra judicial settlement of the offense committed in violation of this ordinance. The offender shall pay to the Municipal Treasurer a compromise settlement fee of not less than P200.00 as maybe agreed by both parties.

Section 6. REPEALING CLAUSE

All Ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof, whose provisions are in conflict with, or contrary to the provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended and modified accordingly.

Section 7. EFFECTIVITY

This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
